

## **4 day/3 night Civil Rights Movement Trip to Birmingham and Montgomery, Alabama**

Travel to Birmingham and Montgomery, Alabama (airfare not included) to deepen your understanding of the Civil Rights movement and the legacy of our history.

Depart Minneapolis on a Thursday morning of your choice in September/October (time of travel negotiable) for noon arrival in Birmingham. Pick up rental car (Economy car provided). Visit the Civil Rights Institute, Kelly Ingram Park, and the 16<sup>th</sup> St Baptist Church in Birmingham.

Spend Thursday night at the historic Hampton Inn Birmingham Tutwiler in a King Room, breakfast included.

Drive to Montgomery on Friday morning – take a six hour guided driving tour of the historical sites in Montgomery, including the Civil Rights Memorial, the Rosa Parks Museum, the National Memorial for Peace and Justice (a very moving memorial to lynching victims) and the Dexter Ave Baptist Church.



Stay two nights at the Hampton Inn Montgomery Downtown in a King Room, breakfast included.

On Saturday morning drive to Selma and visit the Edmund Pettus Bridge, the Lowndes Interpretive Center and the Brown Chapel AME Church. Return to Montgomery in the afternoon to visit the Equal Justice Initiative's (EJI) Legacy Museum (if not covered Friday), the Freedom Riders Museum, and other sites of your choosing.

On Sunday morning drive back to Birmingham for flight home.

### **Trip includes:**

1 night lodging at the Hampton Inn Birmingham Tutwiler, King Room, breakfast included.

2 nights at Hampton Inn Montgomery Downtown, King Room, breakfast included.

3 day economy car rental (driver must be 25 years plus), extra insurance not included.

6 hour guided driving tour of Montgomery through Montgomery tours, in your rental car (entrance fees and lunch not included).

Directions to museums and Selma.

\$100 entrance fee allowance in cash.

### **Exclusions:**

Airfare to/from Birmingham.

All meals other than breakfast, incidentals and gratuities.

Entrance fees in excess of \$100 allowance.
